Lesson: Cell Organelles

- 1. **Autolysis:** Self-destruction of cells by the cells' own enzymes.
- 2. **Cell:** The basic structural and functional unit of living organisms.
- 3. **Cell membrane:** An envelope around the cytoplasm of a cell.
- 4. **Cytoplasm:** The combination of cytosol (which is the liquid part of the cell) and the organelles of the cell.
- 5. **Cytosol:** The liquid part of the cytoplasm.
- 6. **DNA (deoxyribonucleic acid):** An abbreviation for deoxyribonucleic acid which is the inheritable genetic information molecule of the cell.
- 7. Endoplasmic reticulum: Membrane network within the cytoplasm of cells.
- 8. **Lysosome:** An organelle containing hydrolytic, degradative enzymes.
- 9. Mitochondria: Cell organelles responsible for producing energy.
- 10. Nucleus: Large, membrane-bound organelle containing the cell's hereditary material.
- 11. **Nucleolus:** Small, round body of protein that is present inside a cell nucleus.
- 12. **Organelle:** Sub-cellular structure that is present in a cell for a specific function.
- 13. **Plasma:** The straw-colored fluid part of blood, lymph or milk, in which blood cells or fat globules are suspended.
- 14. **Ribosome:** Tiny cytoplasmic organelle containing RNA and associated proteins that takes part in protein synthesis.
